TENDER NOTICE

Sealed competitive tenders are invited from the individual/firms for the works to be taken up at Millet Museum and Crop Museum of the College of Agriculture, Vellayani for the project of "Ecological restoration and Agro-biodiversity conservation at College of Agriculture Vellayani" as per the specifications and terms & conditions detailed below.

DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

Work I:- Construction of boundary foundation for Millet Museum and Crop Museum, individual plot partitioning in Millet Museum and interlocking in Millet Museum and Crop Museum

- a) *Boundary foundation for fencing in Millet Museum to a length of approximately 140 m*
Laying in position cement concrete (1:2:4) for base in 50 cm x 23 cm x 30 cm including all type of material cost and labour cost.
- b) *Boundary foundation for Crop Museum to a length of approximately 110 m*
Laying 4-inch hollow brick with plastering including all type of material cost and labour cost.
- c) *Individual plot partitioning in Millet Museum for 20 plots having size of 3m length, 2m width and 50 cm height*
Laying 4-inch hollow brick, double side wall and top plastering in cement mortar 1:3 including cost of material, labour, hiring charges and transportation charges etc.
- d) *Interlocking in the interspaces in Millet Museum*
Supply and laying of approximately, 1300 sq. ft area with interlock bricks and metal chips etc. including cost of material, labour, hire charges and transportation charges.
- e) *Interlocking in the interspaces in Crop Museum*
Supply and laying of 2980 sq. ft area (approx.) with Interlock Bricks & metal chips etc, including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge etc.

Work II:- Erection of Reaper model fence for Crop Museum, Reaper model fence in front and gate for Millet Museum and chain link fence on sides for Millet Museum.

a) Providing Reaper Model Fence & Gate for Crop Museum (110 meter) x 1.7 meter (W)

Using 40 mm GI Round pipe for post - 1.5-meter height for each 3 meters length, 40 x 20 mm Rectangle Tube for Horizontal pipe 1.7-meter height, 30 meter using 4" Hollow Brick using three side plastering in cement mortar 1:3, including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge, priming & painting etc.

a) Providing reaper model fence in front and gate for Millet Museum

(33 m length × 1.5 m width)

Using 40 mm GI round pipe for post – 1.5 m height for each 3 m length, 40 x 20 mm rectangle tube for horizontal pipe 1.5 m height – 30 m – with pillars of sizes 1.5 m height x 40 cm x 40 cm (2 Nos.) using 4" hollow brick and three side wall and top plastering in cement mortar 1:3, including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge, priming and painting etc.

b) Erecting Chain link fence on sides for Millet Museum (106 m approximately)

Frame work furnishing and fixing of frame using 25 x 25 x 6 mm iron angle with painting (dark green colour); Frame support work – furnishing and fixing of support to frame using 25 mm x 6mm plate with painting (dark green colour); chain link work supply furnishing and fixing of chain links using 2" x 2", 10-gauge GI chain links with priming and painting including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge, priming and painting etc.

c) Passage Arch Fixing Frame work (13 meter length x 5 meter width Area (Approx. 707 sq.ft) in Crop Museum

Using 40 mm GI pipe for post, 1" GI pipe for arch - including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge etc.

Work III:- Providing netting facility for individual plots in Millet Museum and Crop Museum

a) Netting facility in Millet Museum

Providing Seed protecting work- Nylon Net Fixing work (approx 30-meter length x 12-meter width - Frame work - Using 40mm GI Round pipe - 3 meter - 16 Nos. for outside leg, 40mm GI Round pipe - 3 meter - 16 Nos. for inside leg, 10 Gauge GI PVC coated wire for support & nylon net including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge, priming & painting etc.

b) Netting facility in Crop Museum

Providing Seed protecting Nylon Net fixing work (approx 80-meter length x 12-meter width, Frame work - Using 40mm GI Round pipe - 3 meter - 40 Nos. for outside leg, 40mm GI Round pipe - 3 meter - 40 Nos. for inside leg, 10 Gauge GI PVC coated wire for support & nylon net including cost of material, labour, hire, transportation charge, priming & painting etc.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tenders should be submitted in the prescribed form which can be downloaded from the web link Website www.kau.in tenders. The cost of tender form will be accepted by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of *Dean of Faculty, College of Agriculture, Vellayani payable at State Bank of India, Vellayani* and should be enclosed along with the tender. The tender cost and GST amount (18%) should be specified while submitting the tender.

works costing between Rs.1,00,000/- and 10,00,000/-	0.2% of the quoted amount rounded to the nearest multiple of Rs.100/- subject to a minimum of Rs.400/- and maximum of Rs.1500/- + GST 18%
works costing more than Rs. 10,00,000/-	0.15% of the quoted amount rounded to the nearest multiple of Rs. 100/- subject to a maximum of Rs. 25000/- + GST 18%

2. The sealed cover containing the tender should bear the superscription "*works of taken Millet Museum and Crop Museum*" and should be addressed to the *Dean of Faculty, College of Agriculture, Vellayani, Thiruvananthapuram-695 522* as per tender *notice No. GI/B1/14976/2022* dated 14.02.2023"
3. Tender should be accompanied by an agreement in Kerala stamp paper worth 200/- (Rs. Two hundred only), the format of which can be downloaded from the above website. Withdrawal of tenders after its acceptance or failure to execute the work in time or comply with the specification will entail cancellation of tender..
4. EMD @ 1% of the amount offered (subject to a minimum of Rs. 1,500/-) should be remitted along with the tender cost by two separate Demand Drafts drawn in favour of the Dean of Faculty, College of Agriculture, Vellayani, Thiruvananthapuram-695 522 .No other Demand Draft will be accepted.
5. Tenders will be accepted up to 2 PM on 25/02/2023 Tenders received after the stipulated time will not be accepted.
6. Tenders will be opened at 2.30 pm on the same day at the presence of those bidders who are present at that time
7. Prospective bidders may inspect the site before submitting the tenders with prior permission of the Associate Director of Research so as to fix the span and size of the poly house for the area required.
8. Tenders will be opened in the presence of the tenderers who may be present at that time.
9. If the date of opening the tender happens to be a holiday due to unexpected circumstances like bandh, hartal etc., quotations will be opened on the next working day at the same place and time.
10. The Dean of Faculty, College of Agriculture, Vellayani has the right to accept or reject any or all of the offers without assigning any reason. The decision of the undersigned in finalizing the tenders will be the final and binding.

11. The tender accepting authority reserves the right to alter the scope or reduce the quantum of work before issue of work order and the bidder shall not have any claim what so ever on this account..
12. The bidder of the accepted tender should enter into an agreement with the Dean of Faculty, College of Agriculture, Vellayani on Kerala stamp paper worth ₹ 200/-.The format of agreement is available in the web link www.kau.in/tenders. He should also submit a security deposit equal to 5% of the bid in the form of Term Deposit/Bank Guarantee/Demand Draft drawn in favour of Dean of Faculty, College of Agriculture, and Vellayani. payable at State Bank of India, Vellayani.
13. The work should be started within one week from the date of issue of work order.
14. Tenders insisting payment in advance either full or part are liable for rejection.
15. The work bill will be settled on invoice cum cheque basis.
16. Any failure on the part of the bidder in the fulfilment of contractual obligations will result in the forfeiture of EMD/Security Deposit.
17. All other technical and commercial terms and conditions as per the code rules in force in Kerala State will be applicable in this case also. .
18. All the rules and regulations applicable to Government tenders will be applicable to this tender also.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:-

1. Tenders insisting payment in advance either full or in part for releasing the documents through bank are liable to be rejected.
2. The undersigned reserves the authority to accept or reject any or all of the offers for above mentioned work without assigning any reason whatsoever.
3. The decision of the undersigned in finalizing the tenders shall be final and binding.
4. The work should be completed within four months from the date of receiving the work order.
